7:45	<b><u>Priorities for City of Portland Budgets.</u></b> The City of Portland released a very complicated set of budget proposals on 2/28/2025 ( <a href="https://www.portland.gov/budget/2025-2026-budget/development/preliminary">https://www.portland.gov/budget/2025-2026-budget/development/preliminary</a> ). The city administrator proposed major cuts in the Bureaus of Transportation and Portland Parks and Recreation, which are important priorities for our neighborhood, and other potential cuts in many other programs. What does our neighborhood want/need/support for upcoming discussions with city council? District 4 Listening Session is scheduled for April 1. We'll discuss whether to submit testimony on the city's draft budget.
